Happy times in the Philippines! The Philippine Air Force is ready to receive more aircraft and helicopters soon: in 2019 a C-130 and a C-295 are expected to arrive, to be followed in 2020 by six more NC-212is, a G280 and in February six A-29 Super Tucanos.

Also, the first ten S-70i Black Hawks helicopters will arrive, with the balance of the order for a total of sixteen to follow in 2021.

This was announced at the celebration of the 72nd Air Force anniversary by Air Force chief Lt. Gen. Rozzano Briguez. Especially the arrival of the A-29 will mean that the air attack strike operations currently performed by the OV-10 will become considerably more effective.

After delivery, this H145 will complement the current workhorse Philippines Coast Guard Bo105 which has served the agency well for the past 40 years.
